8. Business/Fiscal/Action Items

Martin Coyne presented the 2020-2021 Unaudited Actuals:

The State of California funded all schools based on the prior year Average Daily Attendance (ADA). This helped Manzanita financially because Manzanita had 119 students enrolled during 2019-2020 and 92 students enrolled during 2020-2021.

Manzanita received approximately \$250,000 more than we would have received if the prior year's attendance was not used for apportionment purposes.

Manzanita received \$2,249, 205 in revenue.

The largest revenue was from

1. Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF) \$1, 119,196
2. COVID – 19 Funds 696,272

Total Expenditures was \$1,606,143

The largest expenses were for

1. Salaries & Benefits \$814,295
2. Lease 108,000

Manzanita had a profit of \$636,721 for the year. Manzanita normally has a profit or loss of between \$50,00 and \$75,00 each year. This year, Manzanita received

\$696,272 in COVID – 19 funds. If Manzanita had not received these funds and were funded on 2020-2021 ADA, Manzanita would have a loss of approximately \$310,000.

Manzanita has \$404,501 in the bank and are owed \$823,963 as of June 30, 2021.

Manzanita has sufficient funds to operate for the entire 2021-2022 school year.

Manzanita will need to increase enrollment significantly for the 2022-2023 school year.
